Her black and white photographs of people taken over a 20-year period in the Outer Hebrides, are being exhibited in 'Islanders', a permanent exhibition at the new Museum and Archive Centre at Lews Castle on the Isle of Lewis in the Outer Hebrides.

Monica was on the editorial team of The Royal Photographic Society's PORTFOLIO series of books. As a member of the team she interviewed and wrote about several eminent photographers including Terry O'Neill, Albert Watson, Joe Cornish and David Bailey.

Until recently Monica was a member of The RPS Licentiateship panel, and on the Associate and Fellowship panels in the Contemporary category.

Monica is a freelance writer and has had two true crimes books published.


